



Supplementary Form for Static Houseboats

When the Middle Level Act of 2018 was passed an undertaking was given that the annual level of charges for a vessel that is used as a dwelling for any year in which that vessel does not use any of the waterways in the Middle Level but remains in a marina adjacent to one of those waterways shall be limited to the anticipated cost of:

- (a) administering the application for registration
- (b) checking that the vessel complies with any relevant requirements imposed under any byelaws made under section 12;

and

- (c) enforcing compliance with those requirements.

To prove that the Boat is being used as a dwelling please answer the additional questions below and submit a copy of a current Council Tax demand showing the vessel as the home address.

I confirm that the vessel being licenced is my sole permanent residence for the licensing year being applied for and that I have not lived anywhere else during this period and am not in the process of moving elsewhere.

I confirm that I have not and do not intend to move my vessel from within the marina where it is currently moored at any time and accept that if I do I will be in breach of this licence and will be liable to make payment of the full licence fee without rebate for any fees already paid.

I enclose a copy of my Council Tax demand as evidence that the vessel is my permanent residence.
