The Middle Level Commissioners manage flood protection and navigation through the operation, maintenance, refurbishment and replacement of pumping stations, locks, sluices and manage and maintain 120 miles of open watercourse. In addition, the Commissioners provide management, inspection and repair services for some 33 local Internal Drainage Boards within and around their area, including around 100 land drainage pumping stations.

Job summary

To assist with the delivery of planning and consenting services, including those relating to the provision of consultancy services to other Internal Drainage Boards or third parties. Covering the following:

- Reviewing submissions relating to development and the management of flood risk, surface water and foul water for that site and its impact on surrounding land.
- Liaison with members of the public, site owners and developers who will need information and guidance and to provide answers to planning and consenting enquiries. Undertaking site surveys as required to assist with this.
- To process applications for byelaw consent.
- Attend meeting with other bodies/authorities to build and maintain good working relationships and partnerships.
